

### Adopted by the Board of Directors on 5/18/16 Discrimination Policy

### Harassment Policy

Harassment is generally defined as a course of conduct which annoys, threatens, intimidates, alarms, or puts a person in fear of their safety. Harassment is unwanted, unwelcomed and uninvited behavior that demeans, threatens or offends the victim and results in a hostile environment for the victim. Harassing behavior and communication may include, but are not limited to telephone calls, emails, and other forms of communication, epithets, derogatory comments or slurs, lewd propositions, assault, impeding or blocking movement, offensive touching or any physical interference with normal work or movement, and visual insults, such as derogatory posters or cartoons. # President's Message



## All About Trips

Our first official Membership Meeting of 2017-18 season is coming right up on Wednesday, October 4. You will notice that most of the week long ski trips are full and accepting only waiting list applications at this time. There are still plenty of spaces available on the Keystone trip with a convenient direct flight to Denver, nice condos, and the ability to ski up to 4 different mountains on the same pass. For those looking for a budget trip, you may consider the midweek trip to Stowe or one of the weekend trips we have planned to Snowshoe or Canaan Valley. This month, I'll discuss the process of how we do trips and some of the challenges we face.

It all starts out with a Trip Leader. To become a Trip Leader, the normal process is a progression of experience that starts out as a co-leader with a more experienced leader on a weekend trip. If that person demonstrates sufficient leadership and organizational skills, that person will be approved to run a weekend trip and then ultimately a week long trip. It is a big responsibility to handle the money and paperwork correctly as well as deal with issues that may come up. If you are interested in becoming a Trip Leader, please contact the VP of Trips, Karen Noakes, for more information. One of the reasons we have fewer trips this year is that we have fewer available qualified trip leaders

The Trip Leaders will team up based on experience and familiarity. Each qualified team will submit up to 3 choices for their preferred location and week. A committee will meet to assign the location and week based on several factors, which ultimately must be approved by the Board. This normally occurs in February-March of the year prior to the trip. The leaders will then obtain quotes from tour operators and select the best package. Sometimes, the trip leaders have to change locations because the price is too high or suitable air or accommodations are not available. Once a trip is selected, the leaders will work with the Operator and VP of Trips to work out a contract and deposit. This process normally takes place in March-April, which is a notable exception of the warm weather trip in April, which is several months behind this schedule. The Trip Leaders must then put together a flyer and any other material they need to promote the trip.

Our goal is to publish the tentative trip schedule in the May 1 Pacesetter with the actual flyers in the June 1 Pacesetter. The trips are announced at the same time so that the membership can evaluate each trip equally before making a decision.

There are a number of risks and challenges with scheduling trips. All of the contracts have drop dates where you must release unsold air spots and rooms. These usually occur in late October to early December. This is one of the reasons why so many trips are sold out early. Trips also normally require at least 20 paid people to get the group rate. Sometimes, if not enough people sign up either the prices must increase or the Ski Club must subsidize the trip or at worst case the trip gets cancelled.

Another challenge is that there are only 6 prime weeks to run trips that have a high chance of good snow and do not coincide with holidays and college spring break (high prices, more crowds). In the last few years when we have offered trips later in March or on Holiday weeks, they have not sold well due to those factors.

Let's keep our fingers crossed for a great snow season!




